Preeti-petitioner No.1, aged about 21 years, has performed love marriage against the wishes of her parents with Manjeet Singh-petitioner No.2. Both the husband and wife have filed the present contempt petition with the allegations that inspite of protection granted by this Court vide order dated 12.7.2017, police authorities are raiding their house and thereby disturbing their peaceful marriage.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Sukhbir Singh states that both the petitioners are major in age and have performed marriage as per their own wishes. The allegations of harassment have been denied.

Counsel for the petitioners states that since his clients have not

come forward to file the required affidavit in terms of order dated 23.1.2018, the present writ petition be dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

In view of above, the present petition is dismissed as having become infructuous.
