**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)**

Having considered the submissions made by the counsel for the parties and keeping in view the order dated 04.09.2018, which has been placed on record by the counsel for the State, the contempt, as is sought to be made out by the petitioner for non-compliance of the order dated 24.12.2014, would not be sustainable as in the said order, this Court had decided the writ petition asserting that the matter was squarely covered by the judgment rendered by the Court in CWP No. 22736 of 2012 titled as Jasman Singh vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 10.10.2014. The said judgment of Jasman Singh (supra) was challenged by the State of Punjab by filing LPA No. 2118 of 2014, in which learned Division Bench has proceeded to admit the same and stayed the operation of the judgment passed by this Court on 10.10.2014 in the case of Jasman Singh (supra).

In the light of the said order passed by the Division Bench, the

petitioner cannot take the benefit of Jasman Singh's case (supra) and, therefore, the decision, as has been taken by the respondents dated 04.09.2018, wherein it has been observed as follows:-

“ In view of the facts stated herein above, the claim of the petitioner seeking retrospective promotion with effect from 30.05.2008 qua female employee is hereby subject to the final order to be passed in Letters Patent Appeal No. 2118 of 2014.”

cannot be said to be contemptuous in any manner.

The present contempt petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
