This Court, while deciding CWP No.20509 of 2012, filed by the employer against the Labour Court's Award passed in favour of the petitioner Workman-Mukhtiar Singh, vide order dated 17.03.2015 (**Annexure P-2**) upheld the said Award and directed the employer to reinstate the Workman with continuity of service and full backwages.

The petitioner has filed the instant contempt, alleging violation of the aforesaid order dated 17.03.2015 (**P-2**).

Upon notice, the respondents have filed the reply, stating that the aforesaid decision was challenged by filing LPA No.1255 of 2015, wherein vide interim order dated 27.08.2015, the payment of arrears beyond three years was ordered to be stayed. It is further stated that the aforesaid LPA is pending adjudication for 29.05.2018; and in pursuance to the interim order, the arrears along with consequential benefits of three years stand paid, as also the petitioner has been reinstated. The question of correctness of calculation of the arrears along with consequential benefits would be a subject matter before the LPA Bench.

In view of the above, no further adjudication is required in the present contempt petition.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is dismissed.
