The petitioner-complainant has filed a representation before the Superintendent of Police, Sonipat that Sub Inspector Rajbir Singh had connived with the accused persons in conducting the investigations in case FIR No.344 dated 24.8.2010 for offence under Sections 406, 506 and 420 IPC, resulting into their acquittal. The prayer was thus for taking action against the said police officer. The writ petition was disposed of vide order dated 04.11.2016 by this Court with a direction to take appropriate action on the representation made by the complainant.

Upon notice, reply has been filed on behalf of respondent, wherein it is stated that in compliance of the directions, a speaking order dated 14.3.2017 (Annexure R-3) stands passed, whereby the departmental

proceedings have been initiated against the said official.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted in the present petition.
