Counsel for the petitioner states that the some amount is still due towards the respondents as no interest has been paid to the petitioner.

Let a representation be submitted by the petitioner to the respondents with regard to the claim for interest and the same be considered and decision be taken thereon by the respondents within a period of four weeks from the date of submission of the representation.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to him within a further period of six weeks.

Petitioner may avail of the remedy in accordance with law, if the petitioner is not satisfied with the decision taken by the respondents.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
