JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, Patiala and others (petitioners therein) had filed a writ petition bearing CWP No.22539 of 2016 for quashing the award dated 02.06.2016, passed by Presiding Officer, Labour Court Industrial Tribunal, Gurdaspur (respondent No.1 therein), whereby the petitioner was ordered to be reinstated. In the said writ petition, Civil Miscellaneous No.8715 of 2017 moved by the respondents therein, seeking stay of the impugned award dated 02.06.2016, was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 05.07.2017 (**Annexure P-1**), staying the only the back wages and reinstating the petitioner-Satnam Singh.

On the basis of abovesaid order dated 05.07.2017 (**P-1**), the petitioner submitted his arrival report dated 10.07.2017 (**Annexure P-3**), however, the petitioner has not been reinstated so far, hence, the present

contempt petition.

Upon notice, a reply stands filed and wherein it is stated that in compliance of the order dated 05.07.2017 **(P-1)**, the petitioner has been reinstated into service.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the respondent states that the order in question has been complied with, no further action in the present contempt is warranted as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
