Petitioner had filed a CWP No.1391 of 1997 seeking quashing of the Orders Annexure P-8 and P-8/A in the said writ and further seeks issuance of direction to the respondents to restore back the salary of the petitioner already fixed under the Rules and further not to recover the amount since 1983 claim being old more than 13 years beyond the period of limitation which was disposed of vide order dated 27.03.2017 (**P-1**) by this Court in terms of order dated 11.03.2015 passed in CWP No.17627 of 1996 involving identical issue directing the respondents to release all the retiral benefits as per revised pay scale along with interest @ 6% per annum within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Since the order dated 27.03.2017 passed by this Court was not

complied with. Hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice short reply by way of affidavit of Satish Kumar Ruhil, Senior Mechanical Engineer, Ministers Car Section, Haryana, Chandigarh on behalf of respondent no.3 was filed wherein it is stated that the order passed by this Court was complied with by re-fixing the pay of the petitioner vide order No.195-EA2/GCW dated 29.01.2018 (**R-1**) and as such compliance of the order passed by this Court has been made to which learned Counsel for the petitioner also conceded.

In view of the above, present contempt petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
