Reply by way of affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, has been filed in Court. According to the said affidavit, the claim of the petitioner was duly considered, which was projected in the representation, by holding an inquiry which was marked to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Guru Har Sahai. On inquiry, it was found that the dispute between the parties was already pending in Civil Court and no cognizable offence was made out. Compliance report after the finalisation of the inquiry was also sent to the Registrar (Criminal), Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh, vide letter No.3674/Lit-B dated 03.07.2018 (Annexure R-1).

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous.
