Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that although the disciplinary proceedings initiated against him stands finalized and he has been exonerated therein but the consequential benefits have not been granted to him.

Order dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No. 9923 of 2018, which was preferred by the petitioner earlier, although relates to the grant of consequential benefits such as consideration for promotion but there being no specific direction in this regard, contempt would not be made out against the respondent. The limited direction, which was issued by this Court for finalizing the disciplinary proceedings, stands complied with. Petitioner, if not satisfied, may avail of his remedy in accordance with law, including promotion.

Contempt Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
