The petitioners along with two others had filed CWP No.3116 of 2017 seeking directions to the respondents to decide their representations dated 15.12.2015 and 10.02.2016 with regard to permit the petitioners to continue with the old Pension Scheme (GPF) and to receive the pensionary benefits as already given to the similarly situated employees by this Court in **CWP No.2371 of 2010** titled as '**Harbans Lal Vs. State of Punjab and others**', decided on 31.08.2010. The said petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 17.02.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to the respondents to decide the representations of the petitioners as expeditiously as possible. The petitioners were also directed to file their fresh representations along with certified copy of that order within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The respondents were also directed to dispose of the said representations preferably within a

period of three months from the date of receipt of the said representations along with certified copy of that order. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing today, learned Counsel for the parties submit that the present petition has become infructuous as the aforesaid directions stand complied with.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
