Reply on behalf of respondent No.3 has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. A copy thereof has also been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for respondents-State submits that in compliance of order dated 06.12.2017 passed in CWP No.26657 of 2017 whatever amount is admitted, the same will be released within a period of four months and where there is vigilance enquiry pending, the amount will be released after conclusion of the same.

In view of the submission made by learned State counsel in case the amount is admitted, the same be released within a period of four months only. In case the amount is not released within a period of four months, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the contempt petition and respondents shall have to pay Rs.50,000/- as costs to the petitioner.
