C.M. is allowed subject to just exceptions. The facts and details regarding incorrect calculation of interest on delayed payment by the respondent along with Annexures P-19 to P-21 are taken on record.

COCP-2196-2015

Affidavit dated 09.11.2017, in compliance with the order dated 30.05.2017 passed by this Court, has been filed in Court, according to which, the amount due with regard to the interest has been paid to the petitioner, which fact is disputed by the petitioner, who states that the interest, as is being calculated, is not correct.

Let the calculation sheet be forwarded to the petitioner within a period of four weeks.

In case the petitioner is still not satisfied, he may move a representation to the Managing Director, Confed, within a period of four

weeks from the date of receipt of the calculation sheet. If such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and a decision thereon be taken within a further period of four weeks. In case the amount, as claimed by the petitioner, is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to the petitioner within a further period of four weeks.

With these observations, the present contempt petition stands disposed of.

In case the petitioner is still not satisfied with the response of the respondents, he may avail of his alternative remedy in accordance with law.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
