The writ petition bearing *CWP No.13267 of 2013* filed by the Kharaiti Lal (deceased), who was disabled to the extent of 75%, seeking directions to respondent-Federation to call back him in service and allow him to continue work till he completes the age of 60 years as per the Government Policy decision dated 21.04.2008 duly adopted and implemented by the HAFED, and he may also be held entitled to all consequential benefits, was allowed vide order dated 16.01.2015 **(Annexure P-1)** with a direction *'to reinstate the petitioner by taking his date of superannuation to 30.04.2015 and he would be given consequential benefits within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified*

copy of this order'.

Since the needful was not done within the prescribed time, hence the present contempt petition.

Learned counsel for the respondents points out that an SLP against the order dated 16.01.2015 (**Annexure P-1**), qua which the present contempt has been filed for non compliance, has been filed before the Hon'ble Supreme Court, wherein vide interim order dated 23.02.2017, the operation of the impugned order as well as the contempt order had been ordered to be stayed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal the present contempt petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
