Petitioner-Raj Kumar claims that the respondent-Darbara Singh was required to pay the costs of Rs.5000/- (Five Thousand Only) by way of damages within a period of four weeks from the date of order dated 12.12.2017, passed in review of the initial order dated 19.04.2017 (**Annexure P-1**), i.e. passed by learned Single Judge of this Court in *CRM-M-25662 of 2016* filed by the respondent, seeking directions to the official respondents to conduct a fair enquiry.

At the time of hearing, counsel for the petitioner states that the cost of Rs.5000/- has been paid by the respondent, therefore, no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition, as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
