It is an admitted position that an amount of ₹30,42,838/- has been refunded to the petitioner. Counsel for the petitioner, however, states that no interest, which the petitioner is entitled to as per Section 20 (10) of the HVAT Act, 2003, has been paid.

Since the order dated 02.05.2018 (Annexure P-1) does not refer to any interest, which is liable to be paid to the petitioner, this Court would not be in a position to make any comment on this aspect.

Petitioner may avail of its remedy, in accordance with law, as regards the claim of interest, which, the petitioner states, is statutory.

The present contempt petition is disposed of with liberty, as prayed for.
