AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order passed by the Division Bench of this Court in CWP No. 17675 of 2016 preferred by the petitioners decided on 30.11.2016 (Annexure P-1) by contending that on the lapse of the period of one year, which was granted to the respondents to acquire the land of the petitioners, which exercise has not been done by them, petitioners are entitled to the change of mutation in their favour.

Having considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners and on going thorough the order dated 30.11.2016 passed by the Division Bench of this Court, there is no direction by this Court for change of title of the property nor is there any specific direction with regard to the change of mutation. There is a procedure prescribed under the Revenue Act, which the petitioners should have resorted to instead of approaching the Court through a contempt petition, which, in the considered view of this Court, is not maintainable.

The contempt petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
