AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order dated 16.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CRM-M-14704-2018 titled as Deshpal Singh vs. State of Haryana and others, wherein directions were issued to S.P.Hansi (resondent herein) to consider the complaint of the petitioner and if it appeared that his life and liberty is being threatened, appropriate action, in accordance with law, had to be taken within a period of six weeks.

A perusal of the said order would clearly indicate that the discretion was given to the respondent to act in case of certain contingencies within the specified period of time. The grievance of the petitioner is that he is not being conveyed the decision passed on his representation.

That aspect cannot be accepted in the light of the fact that there was no such direction issued by this Court with regard to conveying the decision of S.P.Hansi in pursuance to the order dated 16.04.2018. No contempt is, therefore, made out in the present case.

The contempt petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
