As per the reply, which has been filed, the orders passed by this Court have been complied with.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that as per the order passed by this Court on 23.04.2010, the payment had to be made within a period of one month from the date of submission of the medical bills by the petitioner for reimbursement of the same.

Counsel for the respondents states that it is not possible to make the payment within a period of one month as the medical bills have to be verified. It is thereafter when the verification with regard to the authenticity of the claim is received, the reimbursement is made. He undertakes that in future, the payments would be released to the petitioner

within a period of 10 weeks from the date of submission of the medical bills.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
