JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The land of the mother (since deceased) of the petitioner is stated to have been acquired in the year 1988 for development of Sector 18, Panipat. The petitioner had filed CWP No.14792 of 2016 seeking direction to the respondents for consideration of allotment of a plot. The said petition stands dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 27.07.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) with liberty to the petitioner to make a detailed and comprehensive representation to the respondents, who shall decide the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the said order, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner in accordance with law. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply by way of affidavit dated 12.02.2018 of Sh. Vijay Rathi, Estate Officer, HUDA, Panipat has been filed, wherein it is submitted that the claim of the petitioner has been considered and the same has been decided by passing speaking orders dated 26.09.2016 and 13.12.2017 (**Annexures R-1 and R-2**).

Learned Counsel for the respondents submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the directions stand complied with. This fact is not disputed by learned Counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
