JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (Barjinder Mohan) had filed a writ petition bearing *CWP No.23804 of 2016*, seeking mandamus to respondent No.2 therein to consider and decide his representation dated 21.09.2016, raising certain objections to the seniority list.

The aforesaid writ petition was *disposed of* by this Court vide order dated 18.11.2016 (**Annexure P-1**), with a direction to respondent No.2 therein '*to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 21.09.2016 within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order*',

Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt

petition.

Upon notice, reply by way of affidavit dated 06.11.2017 of Shri Ajoy Sharma, Secretary, Department of Local Government, Punjab, Chandigarh, on behalf of the respondent, stands filed.

At the time of hearing today, learned State Counsel states that in compliance of the order dated 18.11.2016 **(P-1)**, a speaking order dated 26.07.2017, deciding the representation dated 21.09.2016 of the petitioner, has been passed, rejecting his claim. A copy of the order dated 26.07.2017 **(Annexure R-1)** has also been conveyed to the petitioner and the same is retained for the purpose of record. Therefore, she states that no further action in the present contempt petition is warranted, as the same has become infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner concedes to the aforesaid factual position.

Disposed of as infructuous.
