The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 17.08.2011 (Annexure P-1) and order dated 06.08.2015 (Annexure P-12) passed by this Court.

Learned counsel for respondents-State submits that a representation was made by the petitioner and the same has been considered. Thereafter, a speaking order dated 25.02.2016 (Annexure R-6) has been passed but the same has not been challenged.

However, on perusal of order dated 06.08.2015, which has been passed subsequently after passing of order dated 17.08.2011, a liberty was given to the petitioner by stating that in case any individual grievance was there relating to records of right, the parties would be free to seek appropriate remedy before appropriate Court in accordance with law.

No ground is made out for initiating contempt proceedings.

Dismissed.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy as mentioned above.
