I have heard the counsel for the parties and am satisfied that the
order passed by this Court has been duly complied with as the grievance,
which has been highlighted by the petitioners, primarily is that three of the
petitioners in the writ petition have been granted interest with effect from
14.08.2006, whereas the other petitioners have been granted interest
with effect from 01.07.2009. He, therefore, contends that the other
petitioners have been discriminated against.

It is an admitted position that as per the order passed by this
Court, the petitioners were held entitled to grant of benefit with effect from
01.07.2009. The benefit which has been probably granted to the three

that does not confer any right upon the petitioners.

In view of the above observations, the present contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged.
