Learned counsel for the State has referred to the affidavit dated 26.09.2018 of the Superintending Engineer, Public Health Engineering Circle, Kaithal, according to which a speaking order dated 26.03.2018 has been passed, which is much prior to the filing of the contempt petition. The speaking order dated 26.09.2018 (Annexure R-1) having been passed by the respondent, the claim of the petitioners has been accepted partly and they have been granted benefit of regularisation of service from the initial date of appointment but other benefits have been rejected.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as such.

Liberty is granted to the petitioners to avail of their remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.
