In compliance with order dated 14.08.2018 passed by this Court, affidavit dated 31.08.2018 of Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra has been filed in the Court. In para 4, thereof, it has been stated as follows:-

“4. That in compliance of order dated 14.08.2018 passed by this Hon'ble High Court, the certified copies of the registered gift deeds and the demarcation report of the plots allotted to them along with possession of the plots have been delivered to the petitioners again on dated 29.08.2018 on the spot. The photographs of the petitioners are attached as Annexure R-3. The petitioners in the photographs attached are holding in their hand the Flax Board indicating their plot Nos. i.e. Plot No. 116 and Plot No.119 along with the certified copies of the registered gift deeds, which have been supplied to them on spot on 29.08.2018. Hence, the present petition may kindly be dismissed.”

In view of the above, this Court is satisfied that the order passed by this Court has been fully complied with.

The present contempt petition is, therefore, rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
