AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from Rajesh Kumar, Clerk office of D.R.C.S., Kurukshetra, states that the subsistence allowance for the period 05.11.2015 to 31.03.2018 amounting to ₹3,14,811/- has been credited to the account of the petitioner. He, however, states that petitioner-Gurnam Singh, Peon, has not submitted the certificate regarding he being not working in any Government/private office for the period 01.04.2018 to 30.09.2018. Within a period of one week after the submission of the requisite certificate, the amount due towards the petitioner with regard to the subsistence allowance will be credited in his account.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the respondent, the present contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
