Prayer in this application is for placing on record order dated 23.10.2018 Annexure P-11.

Application is allowed subject to just exceptions.

Order dated 23.10.2018 (Annexure P-11) is taken on record.

COCP No.2285 of 2018

Petitioners have approached this Court by way of the second contempt petition, whereas the earlier contempt petition i.e. COCP No.868 of 2015 was withdrawn by the petitioners on 18.04.2017 (Annexure P-10). Thereafter it is asserted that CM No.14136-CII of 2017 was preferred for recall of the order dated 18.04.2017 and in that said application, on 09.07.2018, the Court had given liberty to the petitioners to prefer a fresh contempt petition in case any cause of action arises.

Perusal of the facts and circumstances of the present case as also the order dated 23.10.2018 passed by the Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Ambala, would not indicate that any fresh cause of action has arisen to the petitioners as what is asserted to be a contempt committed by the respondents is violation of an interim order dated 20.12.2013 passed by the learned Assistant Registrar,

Cooperative Societies, which issue was very much open and it was the reason why the earlier contempt petition has been filed. Even after the final disposal of the revision petition by the Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Ambala, on 23.10.2018, that order would not give any fresh cause of action.

Finding no merit in the present contempt petition, the same, therefore, stands dismissed.
