Petitioner had filed a writ petition bearing CWP No.15918 of 2015, seeking, *inter alia*, directions to the respondents to consider his case for promotion to the post of Assistant Divisional Fire Officer (ADFO).

The aforesaid writ petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 05.05.2017 (**Annexure P-1**), with a direction to the Competent Authority to '*calculate the difference of pay and disburse the same within a period of 3 months from today, since the petitioner had worked against the post of ADFO from December, 2011 to 31.03.2017.*'

Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, a reply dated 20.11.2017 has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record. It is stated that in compliance of the order dated 05.05.2017 (P-1), the benefit of promotional pay scale of the higher post have already been paid by the concerned authorities to the petitioner.

In view of above, counsel for the respondent(s) states that nothing more survives in the present contempt petition, as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
