AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

On 22.08.2016, this Court disposed of CWP No. 18486 of 2015 preferred by the petitioner, whereby respondents were directed to remit 10% of the earnest money deposited by the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had moved an application for modification/clarification of the said order before the Division Bench as she intended to seek refund of the whole amount, which application stands dismissed.

If that be so and keeping in view the reply, which has been filed by the respondents, the amount of ₹60,000/- , which is 10% of the earnest money, which was deposited by the petitioner, stands remitted to the petitioner rendering the present contempt petition infructuous.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
