Power of attorney, filed by the counsel for respondent in
Court today, is taken on record.

Petitioner (Leela Devi @ Leelo) had filed a writ petition
bearing *CWP No. 8649 of 2016* seeking issuance of directions to the
respondents to pay the interest on the delayed payment of Death-cum-
Retirement Gratuity (DCRG) of her husband, which is due from the date of
death of her husband, i.e., 18.01.2012.

The aforesaid writ petition was disposed of by this Court vide
order dated 16.02.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) with the directions '*to respondent
No. 4 to pay the interest @ 9% per annum on the delayed payment of
DCRG to the petitioner, starting three months from the date of death of the
husband of the petitioner till the actual payment, within three months from
the date of receipt of certified copy of the order*'.

Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time of three months, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits/concedes that the order in question has been complied with, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.

Rule is discharged.
