AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court alleging violation of the order dated 16.05.2014 passed by this Court in CWP No.9488 of 2014, titled as 'Usha Rani Vs. DHBVN & others, wherein, operation of the order dated 08.05.2014 was stayed. It has come to the notice of the Court that the said order, which was impugned in the writ petition, was limited to the extent of penalty of ₹ 75,000/-, which was assessed as fee for compounding of offence. The said writ petition was disposed of vide order dated 14.07.2015, wherein, liberty was granted to the petitioner to file objections/review within a period of four weeks and thereafter, the same was to be considered and decided within a further period of four weeks from the date of submission of such objections/review. It has been brought to the notice of the Court that the said objections/review which was preferred by

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the petitioner, stands rejected. The said rejection order has been challenged by filing a civil suit.

Contention of the counsel for the petitioner is that despite the stay order of this Court on 16.05.2014 of the order dated 08.05.2014, the electricity connection was not restored to the petitioner.

This contention of the counsel for the petitioner cannot be accepted as in the order dated 08.05.2014, there was neither an order for dis-connection of the electricity of the petitioner nor was there any specific direction issued by this Court for restoration of the said connection.

In the considered view of this Court, no contempt is made out as has been asserted and alleged. The present contempt petition, therefore, stands dismissed.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
