This order shall dispose of four petitions i.e. COCP No.2332-2017, COCP-1727-2017, COCP-2228-2017 and COCP-2674-2017.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Gurpreet Singh, Chief Engineer (South), Department of Water Supply and Sanitation, Patiala has been filed in court. Same is taken on record. Learned State counsel has referred to para 4 thereof and submits that payment of minimum of the pay scales of the category, to which petitioners belong, has been paid to them. All the petitioners have also been paid the salary consisting of the basic pay in terms of the order passed by the apex court. They have no right to claim allowances in view of the fact that the order passed in LPA No.102 of 2009 has been modified by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

In view of above, all the aforesaid petitions are hereby disposed of. Petitioners shall, however, be at liberty to seek revival of the petitions in case any grouse still subsists. However, in case any frivolous application for revival is moved, this court shall consider for imposition of punitive costs.
