The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 19.5.2016, vide which respondent No.2 was directed to decide the representation dated 15.1.2015 filed by the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of three months.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Shekhar Vidyarthi, Director, Urban Local Bodies, Haryana dated 27.11.2018 has been filed in Court today.

It is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the order has since been complied with.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous. The same is accordingly dismissed.

However, in case the petitioner is aggrieved in any manner with the passing of the order, he is at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.

The Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
