The petitioners are the resident of Village Thouna, Tehsil and District Ropar and alleges that no action was taken by the Deputy Commissioner, Ropar and other official respondents for removing the encroachments over the *Shamlat* land in the Village, inspite of the directions dated 12.11.2014 (**Annexure P-1**), passed by the Division Bench of this Court in CWP No.22950 of 2014.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondent states that in view of the action taken, as stated in the written statement, the present petition has become infructuous.

In response, learned Counsel for the petitioners concedes the aforesaid factual position.

In view of above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
