Petitioner had filed a writ petition bearing *CWP No.8943 of 2017*, seeking quashing the order of dismissal from service dated 01.06.2009 as also mandamus directing the respondents to reinstate him in service alongwith all service benefits.

The aforesaid writ petition was *disposed of* by this court vide order dated 01.05.2017 (**Annexure P-1**), with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 07.02.2017 served by the petitioner by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, separate replies on behalf of the respondents stand filed, wherein, it is stated that in compliance of the order dated 01.05.2017 **(P-1)**, a speaking order dated 11.09.2017 **(Annexure R-1)** has been passed, reinstating the petitioner.

In view of the above, counsel for the parties concede that no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition, as the same has become infructuous.
