The petitioners were claiming substantive promotion to the next higher rank of Head Constable. The writ petition bearing *CWP No.10830 of 2017* filed by them claiming aforesaid relief, was *disposed of* by this Court vide order dated 18.05.2017 (**Annexure P-1**), with a direction to the authorities to '*pass a speaking order within four weeks from the date of submission of their representation*'.

Upon notice, a reply by way of affidavit of *Dr. Naresh Kumar Arora, Inspector General of Police, Administration, Intelligence, Punjab/respondent*, has been filed.

In the reply, it is stated that a speaking order dated 09.08.2017 **(Annexure R-1/T)** in compliance of directions, stands passed . It is further stated that the petitioners have been subsequently promoted to the rank of Head Constable w.e.f. 16.12.2016 vide order dated 25.10.2017 **(Annexure R-2)**.

In view of the reply, counsel for the respondent states that no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition, as the same has become infructuous.

Disposed of.

Rule is discharged.
