Stand of the State is that order passed by the writ court has been complied with. Para 5 of the affidavit dated 10.11.2017 of Dr. G.S. Jakhar, Director General, Animal Husbandry & Dairying Haryana, Panchkula has been referred to. Same reads as under:-

“5. That the office of the deponent has fully complied with the directions issued by this Hon'ble Court vide order dated 17.05.2017 in CWP No.25485 of 2015 within the extended period i.e. 31.10.2017. A team of three experts was constituted to examine the Curriculum/syllabus of diplomas in VLDA course and the representations submitted by the writ petitioners themselves or through their counsels have been decided separately by passing speaking order dated 24.10.2017 by the office of the deponent and the same have been dispatched through registered post on 24.10.2017 to the representationists. A copy of the speaking order No.12922 SE-II/E-2 dated 24.10.2017 dispatched to the counsel for the petitioners in the instant COCP is annexed as **Annexure R-2** for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.”

Aforesaid contention remains uncontroverted, as petitioners remain unrepresented. Similar was the situation on the last date of hearing.

In view of above, this petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. Rule is discharged.
