Petitioner had approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order passed by this Court on 11.03.2014.

Reply to the contempt petition has been filed.

Counsel for the respondents states that the order passed by this Court stands duly complied with and the consequential benefits have also been released to the petitioner. A calculation sheet has also been attached with the reply detailing therein the dues which have been calculated and released to him.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the respondents, the present petition is disposed of as satisfied.

Since the counsel for the petitioner is not present, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a detailed representation to the respondents in case there is some due left out, within a period of four weeks from today.

If such representation is submitted, the same be decided within a period of six weeks on submission of the same.

In case of acceptance of the said claim, the consequential benefits be released to the petitioner within a further period of four weeks, otherwise a speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioner.
