For the reasons mentioned in the applications, the same are allowed and short reply by way of affidavit alongwith documents Annexures R-1 to R-3 is taken on record and exemption from filing certified copies thereof is granted.

Main Case

The contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 19.02.2018 vide which a direction was issued to the respondents to look into the grievances of the petitioners and decide their legal notice dated 22.12.2017.

Reply has been filed. As per the reply, the respondents have looked into the grievances of the petitioners and rejected their claim vide a speaking order dated 19.11.2018.

In this view of the matter, no contempt is made out. The contempt petition is accordingly dismissed.

Rule discharged.

However, if the petitioners are aggrieved by the speaking order,

they are at liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law.
