Counsel for the respondent has also supplied a copy of the order passed by this Court on 17.11.2017 in CM-16230-CWP-2017 in CWP-11686-2017, whereby application for extension of time for compliance of the order passed by this Court on 25.05.2017, has been disposed of by stating that the reasons for delayed compliance of the order has been explained to the satisfaction of the Court

and, therefore, there is no necessity to modify the order dated 25.05.2017, which was originally passed.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous as the direction issued by this Court was limited to the extent of deciding the legal notice submitted by the petitioner, which has been so decided.

The present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged.
