Notice of motion to the respondents to show cause as to why the contempt proceedings should not be initiated against them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner to supply three copies of the paperbook to Ms. Sudeepti Sharma, Additional Advocate General, Punjab during the course of the day.

Although no reply has been filed, learned counsel for the State, however, has handed over a copy of the order dated 26.11.2018 stated to be speaking order passed in compliance of the order dated 11.1.2018 passed by this Court. However, a perusal of the said order shows that same has been passed by IGP Headquarter, Punjab on behalf of Director General of Police, Punjab, whereas, direction was to the Director General of Police himself to consider the claim of the petitioner and decide his representation after affording him an opportunity of personal hearing.

At this stage, learned counsel for the State prays for time to pass a fresh order by the appropriate authority i.e. Director General of

Police, Punjab, after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of with a direction to the Director General of Police, Punjab to pass the said order in compliance of the order dated 11.1.2018 passed by this Court within four weeks from today after granting an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner.
