The petitioner-husband has filed the present contempt with the allegation that the respondent-wife has resiled from performing her part of the settlement *agreement* dated 28.04.2017 (**Annexure P-1**), and, therefore, violated the order dated 05.05.2017 (**Annexure P-2**), passed in the Criminal Revision bearing *CRR (F) No.270 of 2016*, arising out of the maintenance awarded under Section 125 Cr.P.C. by a Family Court.

After hearing learning counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds no ground to continue with the contempt proceedings.

It is conceded position that the petitioner-husband has filed an application for revival of the aforesaid Criminal Revision bearing *CRR (F) No.270 of 2016* and the Court on said application has referred the parties to

the Mediation Centre of this Court.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the parties concede that no further action is warranted in the contempt petition.
