Petitioners have approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order dated 08.02.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No.2355 of 2017, whereby, directions were issued to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated 18.02.2016.

On consideration of the claim of the petitioners as projected in the legal notice, the same has been rejected vide order dated 05.02.2018 (Annexure R-1) by passing a speaking order by the Director Public Instructions (Colleges), Punjab.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous. Disposed of as such. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to avail of their remedy in accordance with law.
