Having considered the submissions made by the counsel for the parties and keeping in view the directions issued by this Court on 13.02.2013 in CWP No.12133 of 2007, especially the instructions dated 04.05.2018, which have been issued by the Government of Haryana, whereby in compliance with the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in M. Nagaraj's case, the exercise has been carried out and the Government has issued specific instructions to fill up the posts after ascertaining the backlog with respect to promotion of Scheduled Castes in their respective Group C and D cadre with effect from 17.06.1995 till date and the said promotions backlog had to be cleared within a period not exceeding four months from the date of issue of instructions.

Counsel for the petitioners states that these instructions have not been given effect to by the concerned department.

That would not be the scope of the present contempt petition. This Court is satisfied that the order passed by this Court stands duly complied with rendering the present contempt petition infructuous.

Disposed of as such.

Liberty is granted to the petitioners to avail of their remedy in accordance with law, if they are aggrieved by the inaction on the part of the respondent in not complying with the instructions.
