The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 3.6.2016, vide which respondent No.2 was directed to pass an order as directed by appellate authority vide order dated 23.4.2013, latest by 31.7.2016.

Reply by way of affidavit of Amardeep Jain, Estate Officer, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran, Faridabad dated 13.12.2018 filed in Court is taken on record.

As per reply, the petitioner was called for personal hearing by the Estate Officer vide order dated 1.9.2017 and also heard personally on 7.7.2017. After hearing the petitioner, speaking order dated 27.10.2017 was passed by the then Estate Officer and the same was also intimated to the petitioner on 27.10.2017.

In view of above, the order dated 3.6.2016 has been complied with. The contempt petition is dismissed accordingly.

However, in case the petitioner is aggrieved with the order dated 27.10.2017, he is at liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
