In compliance with the order passed by this Court, short reply by way of affidavit of the Additional Chief Secretary, Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department, Haryana, has been filed in Court, which is taken on record.

Counsel for the respondents states that the gratuity has already been released to the petitioner on 15.01.2018. As per the above affidavit, after commutation of pension, an amount of Rs.2,52,547/- has been released to the petitioner on 11.09.2018.
