AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court alleging violation of the order dated 11.03.2014 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, whereby in an appeal preferred by him against the order of conviction and sentence passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, by asserting that despite there being stay of his conviction and sentence in the criminal case, services of the petitioner were terminated, which dismissal order was challenged by the petitioner and this Court vide order dated 29.11.2017 in Civil Writ Petition No.12071 of 2014 (Hardev Singh Sodhi Vs. State of Punjab and another) has set-aside the order dated 30.05.2014 vide which he was dismissed from service.

This contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is totally misconceived. The dismissal order, as passed by the respondents, has

already been set-aside by this Court in the writ petition preferred by him. It cannot be said that the order dated 11.03.2014, whereby the conviction and sentence of the petitioner was stayed, has been violated in any manner by the respondents, which would fall within the ambit of the provisions of Contempt of Courts Act.

The present petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
