JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner-Smt. Parvati, who is the widow of late Bchan Singh, had filed a writ petition bearing *CWP No.1350 of 2016*, seeking directions to the respondents to count of work charge service for the purpose of pensionary benefits; modified 2nd ACP Scale from the date of accrual and re-fix the pay of the husband of the petitioner notionally and consequently re-fix the family pension of the petitioner.

The aforesaid writ petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 22.01.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction '*to respondent No.4 therein to take a decision on the legal notice dated 30.11.2015 issued by the petitioner, by passing the speaking order and after affording*

opportunity to the petitioner, preferably within four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.'

Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, a reply stands filed, wherein it is stated that in compliance of the order dated 22.01.2016 **(P-1)**, the representation of the petitioner has been considered by the Competent Authority and after recalculation, an amount of Rs.1,92,442/- by way of cheque **(Annexue R-2)** *qua* benefits of notionally fixation of first and second modified ACP stands released to the petitioner.

In view of above reply, learned counsel for the respondents/UHBVN states that the order in question has been complied with, therefore, nothing more survives in the present contempt petition, as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
