It is the contention of counsel for the parties that in the light of the order, which has been passed by the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Abohar, dated 16.05.2018 (Annexure R-1 with the reply), the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous, although counsel for the petitioner asserts that the claims, which the petitioner has made, have not been accepted in toto and only some of the claims have been accepted.

Counsel for the parties, therefore, pray that the present contempt petition may be preponed from 14.02.2019 to today and disposed of as infructuous.
