Petitioner-Anil Kumar, was a Driver with Haryana Roadways and had filed writ petition bearing CWP No.18373 of 2017 for quashing his relieving order dated 03.07.2017 issued by respondent-Department therein, wherein interim stay was granted vide order dated 01.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court, however, the General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Jhajjar has not permitted him to join, hence the present contempt.

Upon notice, a reply by way of affidavit of Shri Lek Raj, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Jhajjar/Respondent No.2, has been filed,

wherein, it is stated that in compliance of the order dated 01.09.2017 **(P-1)**, the relieving order of the petitioner has been withdrawn vide order dated 22.09.2017 **(Annexure R-1)** and the petitioner has now joined the office on 04.10.2017.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the parties submit that since the order in question has been complied with, no further action in the present contempt petition is warranted, as the same has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
