The petitioner had filed CWP No.4977 of 2017 seeking direction to the respondents to pay a sum of Rs.10 lakh as compensation on account of fault of the Punjab School Education Board, having shown that he has not secured 836 marks out of 1000 in his senior secondary examination from the Board and had secured 695 marks on the basis of which information, he was ousted from the selection of Constable besides suffering other damages on account of wrong information. The said petition was disposed of by learned Single Judge of this Court, vide order dated 31.03.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to the respondent-Secretary, Punjab School Education Board, Mohali to consider the representation dated 2.1.2017 of the petitioner and pass a speaking order and intimate the petitioner about the decision taken by the Board regarding the claim of the petitioner within a period of 3 months after the receipt of a certified copy of that order.

Upon notice, reply has been filed, wherein it is submitted that the claim of the petitioner has been considered and decided by passing a detailed speaking order dated 29.11.2017 (**Annexure R-1**).

In view of the above, no further action is warranted as the directions were to decide the representation of the petitioner by passing a speaking order, which stand complied with

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
